The Society adheres to a Non-Selective program which requires that all FIRST FRESHENER animals on the farm be presented for classification. At the option of the herd owner, any unclassified animals in 2nd or later lactation may be presented for classification and any previously classified animal may be presented for a possible raise in classification.

When applying for classification, herd owners are subject to all existing rules and regulations of the Canadian Goat Society, which govern this program.
