CGS AWARD PROGRAMS

Recognizing those that have shaped the Canadian
Goat Society



Outstanding Animal Awards

The purpose of these awards is to recognize exceptional animals and breeders that have met or exceeded the criteria based on the following point system. This system was designed so that all three CGS Programs; Show, Type Classification and Milk Recording are recognized. At least one point must be earned from each category. Awards may be earned posthumously.

Select Doe

In order for a doe to achieve Select Doe status, she must earn a total of 9 or more points from combining her point total from each of the three categories below, Championship Legs, Production Achievements and Classification Scores. At least 1 point must be earned from each of these categories and a maximum of 5 points may be earned per category.

[A] Championship Legs:

- 1 Leg = 1 Point
- 2 Legs = 3 Points
- 3 Legs = 5 Points

[B] Production Achievements

Milk in the amount of kilograms that are over and above the required *P or number of points required in the case of *M taking into account the age requirement as designated in CGS *P and *M as per official chart.

200-399 kg over minimum requirement	OR	36 kg/bf	OR	18-20 points on a *M	= 1 Point
400-599 kg over minimum requirement	OR	42 kg/bf	OR	20.1 -21 points on *M	= 2 Points
600-799 kg over minimum requirement	OR	48 kg/bf	OR	21.1 -22 points on *M	= 3 Points
800-999 kg over minimum requirement	OR	54 kg/bf	OR	22.1 -23 points on *M	= 4 Points
1000 kg or more over minimum requirement	OR	60 kg/bf	OR	23.1 & over point on *M	= 5 Points

[C] Classification Scores:

VG86	= 1 Point
VG87	= 2 Points
VG88	= 3 Points
VG89	= 4 Points
EX	= 5 Points

Select Brood Doe

A Select Brood Doe Award can be achieved by a doe, which has a combined total of at least three offspring meeting either the Select Doe or Select Sire requirements as outlined, and have officially been designated as such.

Select Sire

In order to achieve Select Sire Status, a Buck must have at least five daughters that have met the requirements to qualify as a Select Doe, and be the progeny of at least two different dams. This award may be given posthumously.

Breeder Award

Master Breeder Award

This award is designed to recognize Breeders who have committed themselves to achieving the highest standards in their breeding program. The award is based on an overall goal towards excellence for type and production in Dairy Goats. To achieve this award a breeder must be a current member of CGS and have bred at least six animals, bucks or does or a combination of both of the same breed, which have been officially designated as receiving any of the preceding awards (Select Doe, Select Sire, or Select Brood Doe). Recipients of this award will be presented a certificate and plaque at the Annual General Meeting and will receive recognition in the CGS QUARTERLY.

Breeder of Distinction Award

The CGS Breeder of Distinction Award should be given to a breeder who has made a significant contribution to a breed as a whole. The respected herd made a substantial genetic contribution to a breed or breeds of goats. The Award is an acknowledgment of a superior breeding program in a herd whose genetic dominance has been duplicated consistently in many herds over many generations.

This Award is granted only to those exceptional herds that have bred some top quality animals, and have contributed significantly to the genetic improvements of the breed(s). These animals bred by the Breeder of Distinction Award recipient have been proven through the participation in the various CGS programs such as Classification, DHIR testing for milk production (*M or *P) and National, Provincial and local show awards. These herds have exceptional milk, classification and show records, and progeny records. This genetic influence is substantial in today's Canadian herds.

The CGS Breeder of Distinction Award is given in gratitude to the dedicated breeder who continually offers the very best to the Canadian Goat Industry and raises the bar of Canadian genetics excellence. The Breeder of Distinction Award recipient(s) will be announced at the Annual General Meeting and published in the Quarterly and CGS Website and Facebook Page.

Certificate of Appreciation
